

HG silver and copper protector

prevents blackness and dulling

The deposits on silver and copper that blacken and dull precious metals are caused by oxidation. Oxidation is caused by the reaction of oxygen and moisture in the air. With HG silver and copper protector a completely colourless, invisible protective layer is applied that hinders this reaction. It is also suitable for brass and bronze.

Instructions for use: If the surface to be treated is dusty, it should be cleaned with a soft, damp cloth, Remove dirty, greasy and silver & copper polish remnants with hot soapy water. Allow the surface to dry thoroughly. Cover the work area surrounding the object (e.g. with foil or newspapers). Shake the spray can well before use. Hold the can upright and lightly spray the surface to be treated, in even strokes and at a distance of approx. 20 cm. To prevent the nozzle becoming blocked. after use hold the spray can upside down and spray until only propellant comes out. If however the nozzle does become blocked. pull it off the spray can and place it in pure acetone for several hours. If necessary insert a fine needle into the spray head. HG silver and copper protector can be removed if required with acetone.

Attention: Transport and store the bottle upright. Do not apply to cutlery and crockery that comes into contact with food or drink.
